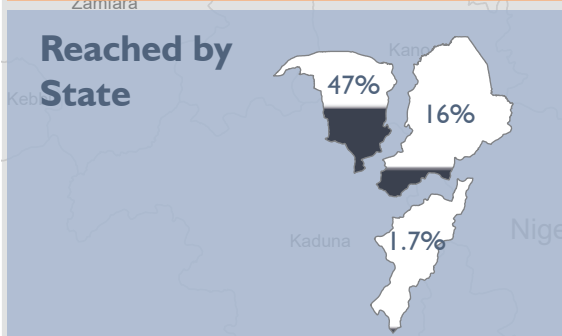
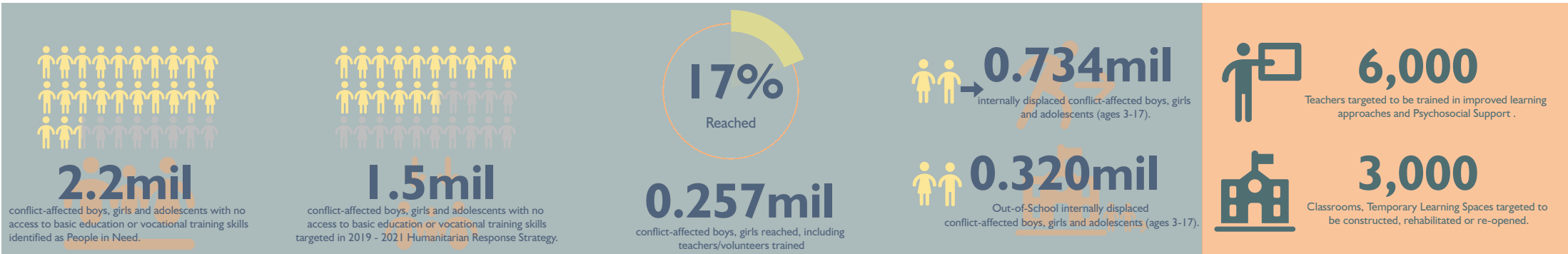


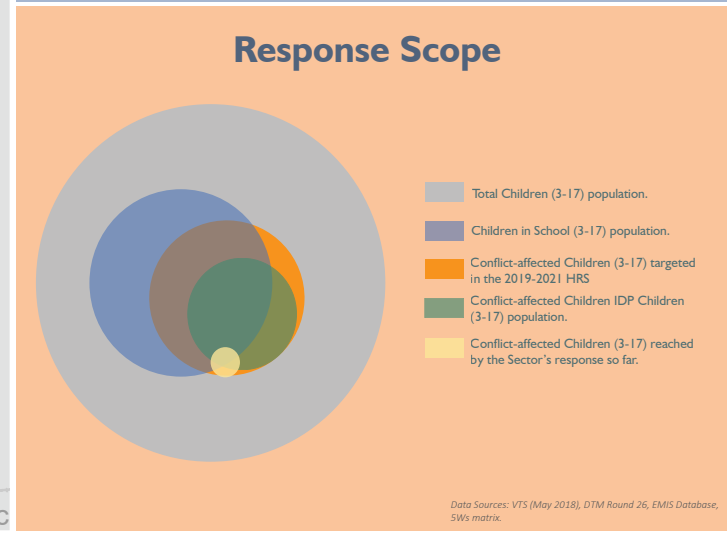
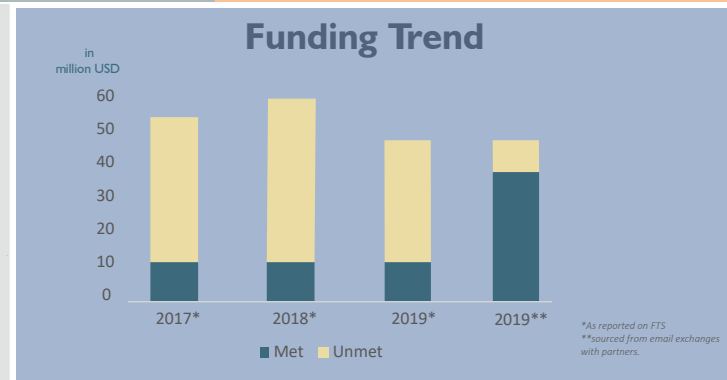
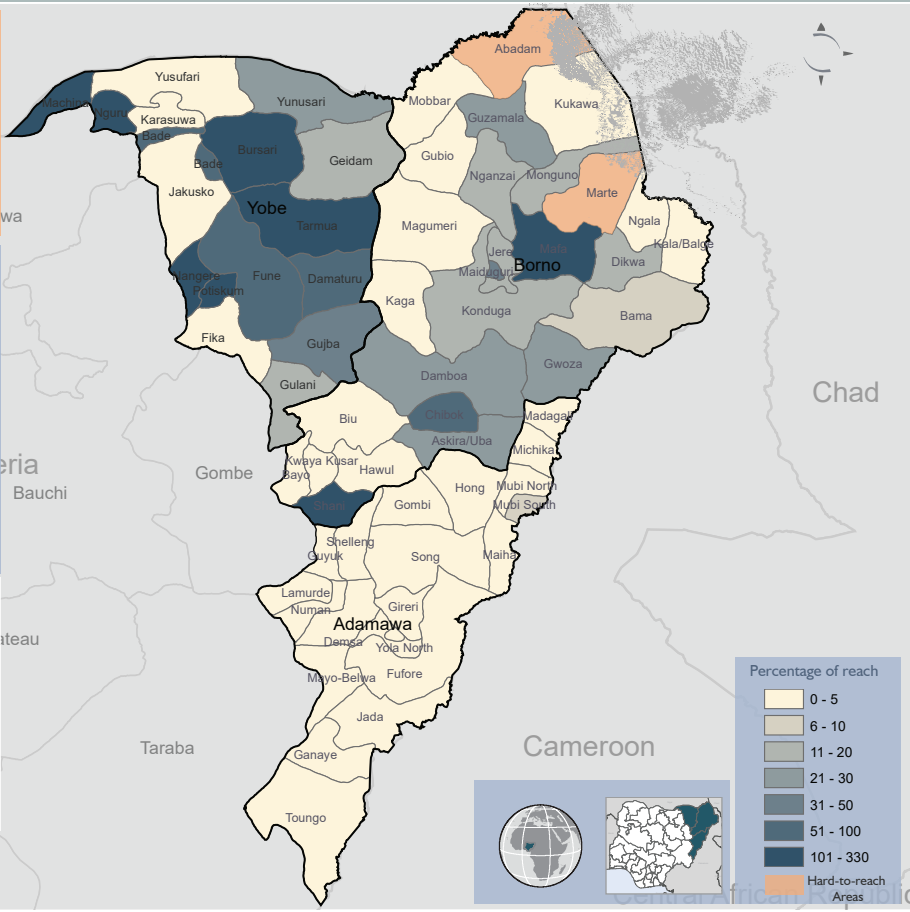
North-East Nigeria: Education Sector Humanitarian Response Plan Dashboard - May 2019
